Parents/Carers of Reception, Year 1 and 2 will need to send disco clothes in a named carrier bag. Children will be changed by their class teacher and school uniform will be placed in the carrier bag. Parents/Carers to collect children from their own classrooms at the end of the disco at 4.00pm. **Please can we ask that younger siblings are collected from the 1st disco promptly at 4.00pm**

Entrance and collection for KS2 pupils (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6) will be at the school hall door.

All non-uniform must be modest; no shoes with heels, jewellery, crop tops (midriff on display) and hot pants (short shorts) are not acceptable. Due to safety and the wellbeing of all our pupils, Elter Walk gate will be locked until 5 minutes before each disco finishes. Due to the office staff helping at the disco, to gain entrance onto school site in an emergency please follow the instructions on the sign at Elter Walk entrance on how to contact Mr Johnson (Site Manager).

To comply with Fire regulations we need to have a list of all children attending the Christmas Disco, please ensure you complete the slip below and return to the school office or via admin@norwoodschool.co.uk

Payment will need to be paid on ParentPay only. **No cash payments will be received through the school office.**

Wristbands permitting entrance will be issued on the morning of the disco only if payment/permission has been received.
