Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the end of the academic year, whilst there are so many activities and events still to go, we look to the start of the next academic year and how we can ensure as smooth a transition as possible for all our children.

To support this important process, the children will have opportunities to visit their new classrooms during the school day, initially with their current teachers. These will be short sessions to help children become familiar with their new learning environment and begin to feel comfortable in their new space.

On **Friday 11th July 2025**, the children will spend the full school day with their new team of adults to ensure that positive relationships are built in advance of the 2025/2026 academic year. Please can your child arrive at school on this day at the usual time and enter through your child's new classroom door. Year 6 pupils will need to come through the community room door on this day where Norwood members of staff will be there to greet them. At the end of the school day your child will be released to their responsible adult or to leave school alone from this door too. If you are unsure of where this door is located, please do speak to a staff member in advance of the 11th July 2025.
