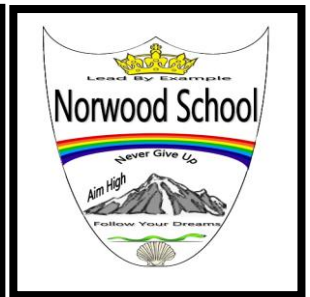

Swimming – Year 4

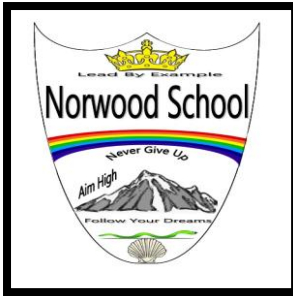

Please remember that Norwood is a nut free school.

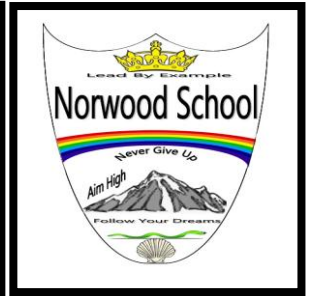
