Carbon monoxide is an invisible, odorless gas that can pose significant risks to health if not properly managed. Our session aimed to raise awareness among pupils about the dangers of carbon monoxide, its sources, and the preventative measures that can be taken to keep homes and communities safe.

This flier contains essential advice on identifying potential risks, tips for installing CO alarms, and what to do in case of exposure.
