There have been a number of absences lately with confirmed cases of Scarlet Fever within the school community.

We informed parents/carers that the recommended period would be 5 days from the start of treatment as per the Department of Health guidelines. We have since been informed of new guidelines from the Local Authority and the recommended period is children can return after 24 hours after starting appropriate antibiotic treatment.
