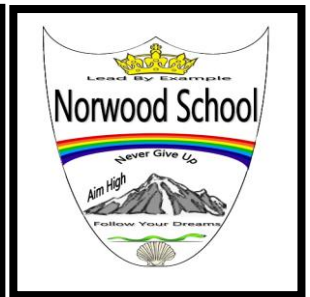

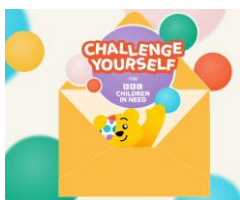
Anti-Bullying Week – Power for Good

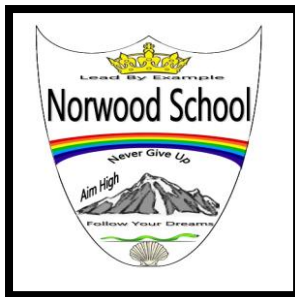

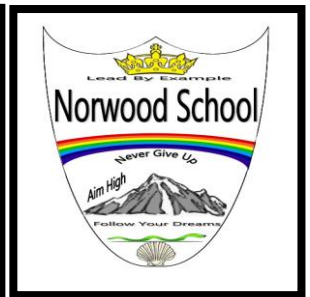
