Parents/Carers of Reception, Year 1 and 2 will need to send disco clothes in a named carrier bag. Children will be changed by their class teacher and school uniform will be placed in the carrier bag. Parents/Carers to collect children from their own classrooms at the end of the disco. **Please can we ask that younger siblings are collected from the 1st disco promptly at 4.00pm.**

Entrance and collection for KS2 pupils (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6) will be at the school hall door.

Due to safety and the wellbeing of all our pupils, Elter Walk gate (opposite the school office) will be locked until 5 minutes before each disco finishes. Due to the office staff helping at the disco, to gain entrance onto school site in an emergency please follow the instructions on the sign at Elter Walk entrance gate on how to contact Mr Johnson (Site Manager). **This gate will be the only gate for entering and exiting the school for bringing and collecting children from the discos.**

To comply with Fire regulations, we need to have a list of all children attending the discos, please ensure you complete the slip below and return to the school office or via admin@norwoodschool.co.uk

Payment will need to be paid on Arbor under School Shop tab. **No cash payments will be received through the school office.** Wristbands permitting entrance will be issued on the morning of the disco to pupils who have permission and payment has been paid.

No slips or payments will be accepted after the deadline-Thursday 5th February 2026.
