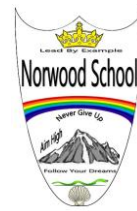

**Red Nose Day – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2026/World Down Syndrome Day – Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2026**

This year, Norwood Primary School will be supporting **both Red Nose Day and the Down Syndrome Association**. The Down Syndrome Association is a charity that directly supports several of our pupils and their families, so it is a cause very close to our school community.

As the two events fall close together, we will be fundraising for them at the same time. **All money raised will be shared equally between the two charities.**

This year we are inviting all pupils and staff to come to school wearing non-school uniform, dress up head to toe in red or wear something funny for a minimum donation of £2 that will go to the 2 charities. We ask that children wear suitable footwear for health and safety reasons. Norwood School Council have also suggested wearing your hair in a funny style!

All non-uniform must be modest; no shoes with heels, jewellery, excessive make up, crop tops (midriff on display) and hot pants (short shorts) are not acceptable. The Head Teacher's decision on the appropriateness of dress is final. We are requesting a minimum donation of £2.00, which will go directly to the charities and should be paid through Arbor. Please log in to your child's Arbor in-app account, and you'll find the donation option under the Accounts tab.

To clarify how the payment works: any donation you make will appear as a credit on your Arbor account, but the money is immediately transferred to the school's bank account. Once all donations have been received, we will remove the item from the system and share the total amount raised for the charities.

Payments can also be made using **Apple Pay**, as long as the Arbor app is updated to the latest version. Keeping the app updated ensures that payment features run smoothly and securely for all parents and carers.
