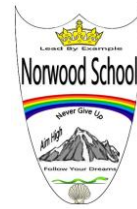

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to welcome you to Norwood School's Sports Day and would like to thank you for your continued support. We hope you enjoy celebrating the children's achievements and taking part in what promises to be an exciting event for all involved.

To provide all pupils with the opportunity to participate in a wider range of events, Sports Day will take place across two mornings:

- KS2 Sports Day: Monday 15th June 2026 – 10am to 11:45am approximately
- KS1 Sports Day: Wednesday 17th June 2026 – 10am to 11:45am approximately
- Please note that the gates will open at 9:45am, allowing you time to make your way to the designated viewing area before the event begins.

In the event of poor weather, unsuitable ground conditions or excessive hot weather, we have scheduled provisional reserve dates. Key Stage 2's reserve day will be **Monday 22nd June 2026**, and EYFS & Key Stage 1's reserve day will be **Wednesday 24th June 2026**.

Both events will take place on the school field (weather permitting).

Please can we take this opportunity to remind parents/carers that all children need to come to school with a filled named water bottle and a sun hat. Sun cream should also have been applied before coming to school. Pupils should also come to school wearing their PE Kits, with the top being of the same colour as their 'house' (if you are unsure of this, please speak to your child's class teacher). Long hair needs to be tied up and earrings removed or covered.

There is no need for pupils to bring their school uniform to school on their sports day.

Parents/Carers are welcome to bring their own chairs or blankets as these will not be provided by school.

Parents and Carers are not to approach the pupils throughout the morning, Norwood staff will be on hand should there be a need to offer pupils support.

Please can we remind all visiting family members that, for GDPR and safeguarding reasons, photographs and videos are not permitted during the event. We kindly ask that all parents, carers and visitors respect this policy to help us protect the privacy and safety of all pupils.

For the safety and security of all pupils, parents/carers are asked not to walk around the school site on Sports Day. **Please enter via the Coniston Road entrance ONLY and proceed directly to the school field. Thank you for your cooperation.**

Where possible, sibling races have been carefully staggered to allow families to watch both children compete. In most cases, parents and carers will also be able to stand between the two tracks where their children are racing, making it easier to support and watch both events.

However, due to unforeseen circumstances and the nature of the event timetable, there may be occasions where siblings are required to race at the same time. We kindly ask for your understanding and support should this happen.

Please note the following information regarding awards and participation:

- All pupils who take part in races will receive a participation sticker.
- Pupils finishing in 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will receive the corresponding achievement stickers.
- To help prevent stickers from being lost and to avoid any disappointment, participation and achievement stickers will be presented to pupils during a classroom awards ceremony following Sports Day.
- Medals will be awarded to every participant involved in the "Best of the Best" Relay, including those finishing in 4th place.
- Special awards will also be presented for: Sportsmanship, Excellent Effort and Supportive Stars

The House Cup and all Special Awards will be presented during assembly on Thursday 25th June 2026.

Thank you once again for your support. We look forward to welcoming you and celebrating the children's enthusiasm, determination, and teamwork throughout the event.

For ease of access and another reminder, all parents and carers attending Sports Day are asked to enter and exit the school site via the Coniston Road entrance only. This entrance will be used exclusively for parents and carers attending the event.
