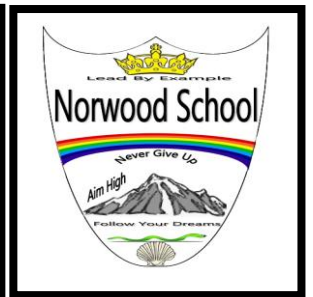

hay fever that the appropriate medication has been taken before coming to school. Any prescribed medication for hay fever must come to the office and a form completed.

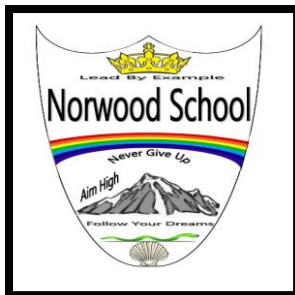
Please do not leave any medication in school bags.

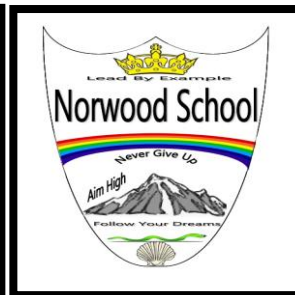
