Dear Parents/Carers

We are fast approaching Norwood School's performance of *The Jungle Book* at The Voyager School on **Thursday 26th March 2015**.

In year 4, we will be performing a piece based on the scene where the monkeys kidnap Mowgli and he encounters King Louie. This will include some dancing, acting and narrating, bringing our own interpretation of events alive.

For the evening performance your child will require a costume:

- Each child will have an option to choose a character they wish to play. They will then need to **create a mask** based on this character, which has been given to them as their home learning project for this term. The aim of the mask is to give the audience an idea of the animal they are playing so that the clothes they wear can be quite plain if they wish.
- If your child is playing one of the **monkeys**, all they need for their costume are a plain brown long sleeved top, brown long log bottoms, brown socks and a long brown tail. Is they wish, they can also wear brown ears on their head too.
- If your child is one of the specific characters, they will need a similar costume to the monkeys but in the colour their animal should be.

Baloo – a large brown bear;

Bageera – a black panther;

King Louie – an orange/red orang-utan;

Kaa – a brown/grey snake

Shere Khan – a tiger

- If your child is **Mowgli**, they will need a plain, flesh/pale cream coloured top, red shorts and brown plimsolls or similar that are appropriate to dance in.
- If your child is a **narrator only**, they will need to dress like one of the monkeys but can wear plain brown or black plimsolls/trainers if they wish.
