This will take place on **Tuesday 7th July 2015**.

Legislation regarding sex education acknowledges that parents/carers have a right to withdraw their children from all or part of sex education outside National Curriculum orders. Parents/Carers considering such action are welcome to discuss this with Mrs Reynolds.
