Dear Parents/Carers

The Governing Body of Norwood School has role and responsibility for writing and agreeing the policies that the school and staff must implement on a daily basis.

We have reviewed our School Uniform Policy to ensure that all of our school community have a clear understanding of the requirements for the children of our school.

The document sets out the clothing items and colours required for school day wear and also for P.E. activities.

Due to constructive feedback from parents/carers we have included 'poppy red' polo shirts and P.E. t-shirts in this policy to clarify that these are now permissible as our part of our uniform.

The vast majority of our families work very well with school and communicate positively with our staff over important issues. We do understand that occasional short term issues may arise that prevent children from being in school uniform for a day or so and we ask that parents/carers share this with school should it arise. We have made provision in our policy for rare occasions such as this; however the policy does then set out the procedures that school must follow for 'non-compliance' outside of this.
