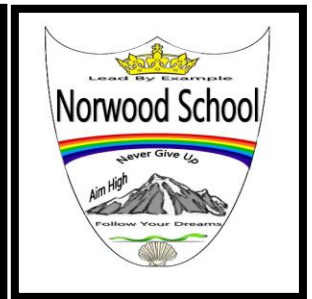

Please remember that if your child has sickness or diarrhoea they must be kept off school for a minimum of 48 hours from the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting.
