


# Norwood Primary School NEWSLETTER May 2016 Head Teacher—Mrs D Reynolds

Please can we again remind parents/carers that the bike stand outside the school office is for **adult bikes only**. Please use the secure bike store for all children's bikes and scooters.


#### **Disabled Parking**

# Children should not be left unsupervised at any time in the car park.


# Water Bottles
