Reading and Writing

We have slightly adapted how we approach the teaching of Reading and Writing in KS1. We now teach a short phonics session every day where the children attend their Read Write Inc group, but the main teaching consists of Guided Reading. The children complete spelling, grammar, punctuation and writing activities across the week and this has had an incredible impact on the children's confidence with both reading and writing.

Mathematics

- Mentally adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers to

- Handling coins up to 20 pence and solving one step problems i.e. 7p+?=10p
- Recognising 3D shapes
- Describing movement i.e.
 clockwise and anti-clockwise

- How the season will change from Spring to Summer
- Can we make a teddy fly?

PSHE/RE

- This term we will be discussing how Christians worship
- Safety contexts including safe spaces to play, and how to conduct ourselves safely when we are out and about
